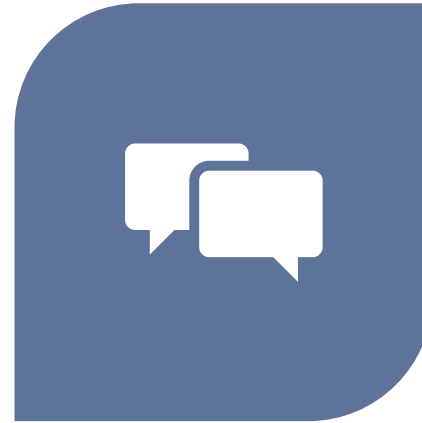

When writing a prompt:



Keep in mind the target audience



Keep in mind the CEFR level



Keep in mind which output you want to get from the AI engine.

Speaking Activity: Airport Communication Role-Play

Objective:

Students practise basic English communication used in aviation-related business situations (check-in, boarding, customer service).

Level:

A2 (CEFR)

Duration:

20–30 minutes

Materials:

- Role cards (included below)
- Optional: simple props (boarding pass template, airport signs)

Activity Description:

Step 1 – Introduction (5 minutes):

Explain to the students that they are going to practise real-world conversations at the airport. Emphasise that polite, clear communication is very important in aviation business.

Step 2 – Role Preparation (5 minutes):

Divide students into pairs or small groups. Give each student a role card. They take one minute to read their role and prepare what they want to say.

Step 3 – Role-Play (10–15 minutes):

Students act out their dialogues.

Encourage natural conversation: greetings, questions, checking information, thanking each other.

Step 4 – Feedback (5 minutes):

Briefly discuss:

- What went well?
- Which polite expressions were used?
- What new words or phrases did they use?

Output:

Role Cards:

✈️ 1. Check-in Desk Agent

- Greet the passenger.
- Ask for a passport and ticket.
- Ask how many bags they have.
- Give information about the gate and boarding time.

✈️ 2. Passenger

- Greet the agent.
- Give your passport and ticket.
- Ask if you have time for a coffee before boarding.
- Thank the agent.

✈️ 3. Flight Attendant

- Welcome the passenger on board.
- Show them where to put their luggage.
- Explain how to fasten the seatbelt.

✈️ 4. Passenger

- Greet the flight attendant.
- Ask for help with your bag.
- Ask what time the flight will arrive.

Language Support (for students):

Some useful phrases to display on the board or give on a handout:

- "Good morning! May I see your passport, please?"
- "Your boarding gate is A12."
- "Can you describe the item?"
- "The flight will arrive at 3:45 PM."
- "Thank you for your help."

Tips for the Teacher:

- Model an example conversation first.
- Correct errors gently, focusing on polite phrases and correct tense use.
- If needed, allow students to repeat the role-play with a new partner.

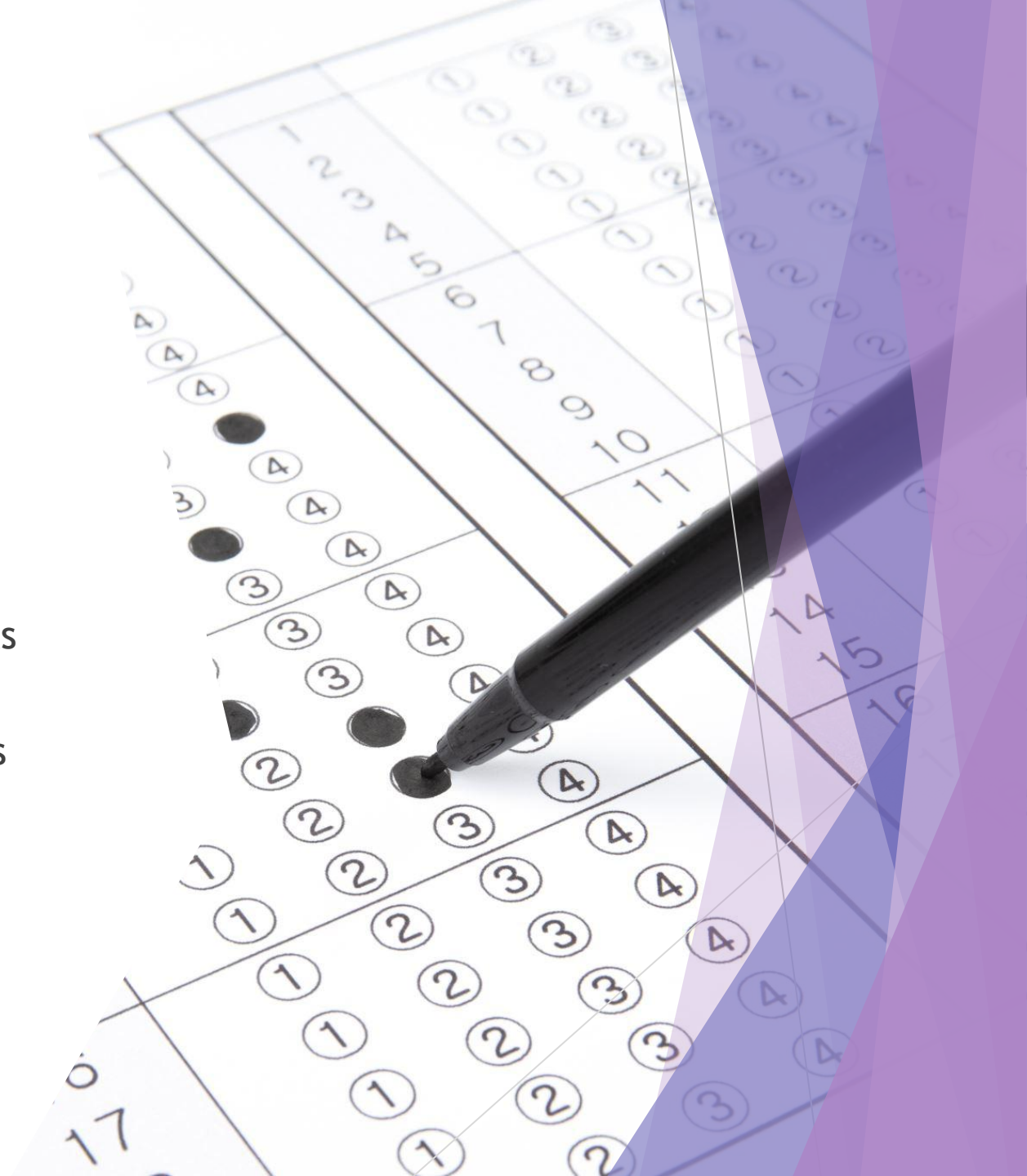
